Registration, Evaluation and Authorisation of Chemicals. (REACH)

REACH (Regulation EC 1907/2006) is the European Community Regulation on chemicals and their safe use; it deals with the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemical substances. The law entered into force on 1 June 2007 with the specific aim to improve the protection of human health and the environment. It places greater responsibility on industry to manage the risks from chemicals and to provide safety information on the substances.

Polyco Healthline Limited works in compliance with the regulation and as a downstream user under article 33, we understand that although we are not liable for the registration of substances, we would be required to provide a declaration if any part we supplied had more than 0.1% of any Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC).

All products supplied by Polyco Healthline Limited comply with EU Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 concerning the Registration Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals.
